

Privacy Statement

This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us.

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), effective on 25th May 2018, gives data subjects (living individuals in respect of whom personal data is processed) enhanced rights and protections in relation to their personal data. We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of the users of our services.

Therefore, we have updated our Privacy Policy, so we are completely clear as to what personal data we collect, why we collect that personal data and how we handle it.

Data Protection

For the purpose of the act Document Data Group is the data controller and sole owner of the personal data collected from you.

Document Data Group is committed to respecting your right to privacy and data security on the web and to responsibly handling the information you provide.

We shall undertake all commercially reasonable steps to prevent the unauthorised disclosure of your personally identifiable information to third parties, except as required by law. Document Data Group will never sell your information for marketing purposes to outside third parties and all personal data will stay within the EEC.

Information we may collect from you

It is not necessary for you to register with us in order to access the website. However we may collect some information from interactive features such as contact and registration forms. The basic personal information about you which we may collect and process is as follows: -

We may also collect and process information provided by you at the time of posting material to the website, as well as details of your visit to the website (including, but not limited to traffic data, location data, weblogs, your company hardware and software and other communication data.) and the resources that you use. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring web site addresses. Uses made of the information

We may use the information held about you in the following ways: -

Storage and deletion of personal data
